

GIFT AID DECLARATION



Using Gift Aid means that every pound you give, we get an extra 25 pence from the Inland Revenue; helping your member subscriptions go further.

This means that £20 can be turned into £25.00 just so long as subscriptions are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing!

So if you want your subscriptions to go further, Gift Aid it. Just complete this form and send it back to us.

NOTES

1. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or Capital Gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity (Scout Group) reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1.00 you give).
2. You can cancel this Declaration at any time by notifying the charity (Scout Group).
3. If in future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and Capital Gains equal to the tax the charity reclaims, you can cancel your Declaration.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment Tax Return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask the charity, or ask your local Tax Office for leaflet IR65.
6. Please notify the charity (Scout Group) if you change your name or address.
